**Season Commences:**

**Wednesday 11 February 2026**

New format for Wednesday Competition in 2026. Seven rounds and a Grand final for a total of 8 weeks will be played during each school term. Competitions will be known as Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring.

**PLEASE NOTE:** Game times will be 6.30pm, 7.30pm and/or 8.30pm

Junior: (12-17&under) (\$73 NV + \$73 WNA) \$146

**Grand Final Only:** Wednesday 1 April 2026 (1<sup>st</sup> v 2<sup>nd</sup> on the ladder after seven (7) rounds)

**Team Manager** to create Team Registration online Registration on Netball Connect:

1. Login on Netball Connect and sign up to the Competition by scrolling down the screen to “**+New Team Registration**” on App or through website.
2. Add required information and you can continue without adding team members OR enter players if you know their date of birth, mobile, and email (all mandatory fields). (csv file can be created and downloaded with all player details).
3. Each team member added on Netball Connect team registration will receive an invite email notification from Netball Connect to register and pay the required fees.
4. Players can be added later via your UserProfile > Registration Tab > select team registration > +Add Players.
5. Additional information is available on Netball Victoria / Netball Connect page under Resources.
6. Please email the completed Team Registration form (available on WNA website) of players intending to play with your team by **28 January 2026** to [competitions@wangerattanetball.com](mailto:competitions@wangerattanetball.com) including team contact details to enable WNA to check that your players have registered to the correct team.

### Player registration

- Players must register online for their Netball Victoria and Wangaratta Netball Association registration via the link on the Wangaratta Netball Association website/competitions/Registrations **OR** Netball Connect App **OR** <https://vic.netball.com.au/players>.
- If you have any trouble registering contact us at [competitions@wangerattanetball.com](mailto:competitions@wangerattanetball.com) with the player's full name and date of birth.

### Team Manager

- Any player 12 years of age in the current year is eligible to play in the Autumn competition.
- Team Manager responsible for ensuring all players are registered or obtain an online Single Game Voucher for fill-ins **before** the player takes the court. As per WNA By-Laws teams will lose premiership points for any player not registered **before** taking the court.
- Registered players must play at least five (5) games with their team throughout the season to be eligible to participate in the final series.
- Single Game Vouchers do not contribute to finals eligibility for any Competition.
- No player is permitted to play for more than one (1) team per competition round.
- The Team Manager is advised to ask for proof of registration before the player takes the court. Netball Connect sends a registration email to all players.
- A player must purchase a Single Game Voucher online via Netball Connect prior to taking the court for a team and this voucher must be used on the same day.

Single Game voucher cost:

Netball Victoria and WNA fee - Senior \$15

Netball Victoria and WNA fee - Junior \$13

## POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM TEAMS:

- If players are ineligible, ie. not paid full Netball Victoria and WNA fees or obtained a player voucher
- Players registered with a team are not permitted to play for another team at any time.
- Team Manager responsible for advising new players of the registration process.
- Netball Victoria Regulations require any adult in a position of responsibility including coaches, umpires, and Team Managers to maintain a valid Working with Children Check and must provide evidence to WNA before the first Round.
- All teams must provide their own bibs and basic first aid kit.
- There should be a scorer from each team who stands beside each other; if a junior is scoring an adult must stand beside them.

## Dress Code

- Dress, polo shirt or t-shirt & skirt/shorts colours must be the same for all players in the team. Reminder that singlet tops are not permitted and players will be asked to leave the court.
- Polo shirt, t-shirts, or long sleeve t-shirts must be the same design and must be able to clearly display a playing positional bib.
- Teams are asked not to wear **white tops** to avoid clashing with umpires who will be wearing white polo tops.
- The choice of bottoms must either include the same design as the dress/top or could be a designated block colour to match the uniform (ie, black, royal blue, navy blue etc). Includes shorts, skins/leggings as long as they are completely black, white or in a block colour to match the uniform.
- Uniforms must not present a genuine safety risk to the wearer or other players (ie, open pockets, buttons, or zippers).

## MIXED COMPETITION

- Maximum number of males on the court at one time is three (3) males.
- It is not necessary for a male player to be opposed to a male player.
- A mixed team must only have up to one male in each third on court at the one time. For the avoidance of doubt this means:
  - I. One male is permitted in either Goal Defence or Goal Keeper
  - II. One male is permitted in either Centre, Wing Defence or Wing Attack
  - III. One male is permitted in either Goal Attack or Goal Shooter  
eg GD, C, GA or GS, WA, GD

## Other

- WNA By-Laws are available on the website or at Clubrooms
- Codes of Behaviour for players, umpires, coaches, parents, and spectators are available on the WNA website.
- Players are encouraged to download the Netball Connect App for the fixture, results, ladders plus the registration process.
