Step 1 Netball Connect direct digital Team Registration – Team Manager only

Team Manager ONLY to register Team in NetSetGo Competition – Grade 3 & 4:

1. Team Manager: creates own new user register on Netball Connect using your email & create a password
 2. Sign up to Competition: select “**+New Team Registration**”
 3. Select Organisation: Wangaratta Netball Association
 4. Select Competition: **NetSetGo Competition – Grade 3 & 4**
 5. Select Membership Product: Select Senior or junior membership
 6. Select Division: **Grade 3 or Grade 4**
 7. Click “Sign Up to Competition” (bottom right)
 8. Person Registering role: Select Team Manager and complete your own personal information
 9. Enter Team name
 10. Continue without adding team members **OR** enter players if you know their date of birth, mobile, and email (all mandatory fields).
Each team member entered on team registration will receive an email notification from Netball Connect to register and pay the required fees.
 11. (Players can be added later by your User Profile > Registration Tab > select team registration > +Add Players)
 12. Click the NEXT box and complete additional personal information for yourself
 13. Click “Sign Up to Competition” box (bottom right)
 14. Confirm payment by clicking “Submit”

 - Please forward completed Team Registration form of players intending to play with your team by **26 April 2024** to WNA Committee (netsetgo.wna@westnet.com.au) so we can check that your players have registered to the correct team and allow you to check your team registrations on the app.

- Netball Victoria Regulations require coaches, team managers, and umpires over 18 years of age to maintain a valid Working with Children Check and must provide evidence to WNA before the first round.
- Team names are not to include a reference in any form to a school. Team names will only be changed after registration if we have duplicate team names.

Step 2 Players, coaches and umpires register to digital team registration

- Advise all intending players of the team name to ensure they register to the correct team
- Players must register online for their Netball Victoria and Wangaratta Netball Association registration via the link on the Wangaratta Netball Association website/competitions/Registrations OR Netball Connect App OR <https://vic.netball.com.au/players>
- Parents to create their own Netball Connect login then add child under their profile (+new participant registration).
- Players to complete their online registration a fortnight prior to the competition commencing.

Team Members register to Saturday NetSetGo Competition – Grade 3 & 4

New register

1. Select “**+New Participant Registration**” completing all required fields
2. In “**Find Competition**” type in “**3677 or Wangaratta Netball Association**”
3. Select Saturday NetSetGo-GO competition and team you are registering with
4. Select Membership Product then click “**Add Competition and Membership**” box (bottom right)
5. Confirm payment by clicking “Continue” and “Submit”

Existing Netball Connect account

1. Logon and select player to be registered
2. On the User Profile page click on “**ACTION**” box (top right) and scroll/select “**Register**”
3. Check Profile and click NEXT
4. In “**Find Competition**” type in “**3677 or Wangaratta Netball Association**”
5. Select Competition: **NetSetGo Competition – Grade 3 & 4**
6. and team you are registering with
7. Select Membership Product: Player Membership-Junior player
8. Select Division: Grade 3 or Grade 4 then click “**Add Competition and Membership**” box (bottom right)
9. Confirm payment by clicking “Continue” and “Submit”

- Players must complete their registration a fortnight prior to the competition commencing. Participant packs will be distributed directly to each participant from the time of their NetSetGO registration. Please allow 21-28 days delivery after registration.
- Include Participant Pack T-shirt size on the registration form and ensure the address is correct.

Additional Information – Team Managers/Coaches

Conduct of Game

- NetSetGo players cannot play in the Junior competition.
- Coach or Team Manager must report to clubrooms and confirm the number of players available on game day at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled game start time.
- No jewellery, earrings, or adornment may be worn during the game. Taping of nails or jewellery is not allowed. Please support the umpires in enforcing these rules.
- All players to be in appropriate uniform when taking the court (Girls-skirt; Boys-sport shorts plus polo shirt or t-shirt) in the same colour. Long-sleeved tops and leggings are permitted during cold weather.
- All players should receive equal court time during the season and have the opportunity/be encouraged to play all different positions.
- Only in NetSetGO can players be moved from one team to another to ensure a game can be played. Wangaratta Netball Association's aim is to maximize on-court practice as part of learning for NetSetGO players.
- **Grade 3 section:**
 - Coach to umpire for their team and may enter the court. If a parent is allocated to umpire instead of the coach, the coach cannot walk onto the court during the game.
 - Round 1 to Round 6 - goal posts will be lowered.
- **Grade 4 section:**
 - Round 1 to Round 6 - Coaches are allowed to coach along the sidelines without interfering with the umpires BUT NOT ON THE COURT.
 - Round 7 onwards – Coaches to remain in bench area as part of the transition to junior netball.

Umpires

- As part of our Umpire Pathway program beginner umpires will be allocated to Grade 4 NetSetGo teams to commence their practical court time.
- Committee request that you assist and encourage them in this extremely challenging role as they learn.

Injury

- In NetSetGo games the umpires should use their own discretion when allowing a player to return to the game. This applies to players arriving late as well as players who have left the game for injury or under the blood policy.
- All injuries are to be reported to the Clubrooms and an Injury Incident form is completed at the discretion of the injured player or player's guardian.
- Blood rule – any player who is bleeding must be removed from the court immediately to be attended to.
