Conditions of Entry

- We reserve the right to restrict the number of teams entered by any Association in each section if we have too many entries.
- Team Registration form to be emailed to wangnetball@westnet.com.au (pdf format only) (do not post entry).
- Team entries close on **1 April 2021** and Associations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. A waiting list will be available.
- Entry fee of **\$100 per team** to be paid when emailing Team Registration form to secure entry.
- Teams withdrawing after 13 April 2021 will forfeit their entry fee.
- Championship and Reserve sections depend on entries.
- All teams must supply one non playing umpire – preferably badged.
- Request umpire name and grade fortnight prior to Tournament (finals preparation). All umpires **MUST** be available for finals.
- Wangaratta Netball Association will not be providing umpires for visiting teams.

Player Eligibility

- Players must be registered with Netball Victoria or Netball NSW.
- Players may only play for one team throughout the day.
- Teams playing ineligible players may be eliminated from the event.
- To be eligible to play in finals a player must have played with that team during the preliminary games on the day.

Registration

- All teams and umpires must report by 8.30 am. Tournament commences at 9.00 am sharp.
- Compulsory Umpire briefing at 8.45am.

Matches

- All games played under the rules and regulations of Netball Victoria.
- Games shall consist of two seven (7) minute halves by central timing.
- At half time there will be a one (1) minute break then teams change ends and play on umpires whistle after the siren.
- Five (5) interchange players are allowed at half time (except 11&U).
- No injury time, however the umpire will allow time for an injured player to be replaced.
- Two (2) minutes between each round.
- The Tournament Committee has the right to regrade teams if necessary.
- Any team not ready to take the court at the scheduled starting time of their game shall:
 - i) Forfeit two (2) goals for every minute late.
 - ii) Forfeit the game if the team fails to take the court after two (2) minutes of the scheduled starting time.
- In the event of any team forfeiting during the day all following rounds will be treated as a forfeit.

- Forfeiture will result in a score adjustment of 0-6.

Score Sheet

- First named team has the centre pass and the second named team has the choice of end in the fixture games.
- Each team to provide a scorer. The scorers are to stand together away from spectators/coaches. The score sheet is the official form. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The winning team to deliver score sheet to Control Room **immediately** after the game.

Drawn Games

- Fixture Games – Teams will take two (2) points each.
- Final Games
 - i) At the end of the game, when the scores are tied, there is a one (1) minute break during which time there may be substitutions and/or team changes.
 - ii) At the end of that minute, teams change ends and 2 x 3 minute halves are played.
 - iii) At the end of the first three (3) minute period there will be another one (1) minute break during which time there may be substitutions and/or team changes, teams shall then change ends and play the second three (3) minute period.
 - iv) If, at the end of the second three (3) minutes the scores are still tied, then play continues until one team has a two (2) goal advantage.

Finals

- The top two (2) teams from each pool will participate in finals (dependent on number of entries and sections).
- Finals structure will be determined by entries in each age group.
- The first centre pass will be determined by a coin toss, opposition team shall have choice of end.

Trophies

- The winners and runners-up will receive 10 individual trophies

Refreshments

- Canteen and BBQ available throughout the day.
- NO outside BBQ's to be brought due to OHS regulations.

Other

- First Aid will be available all day. No pregame strapping available.
- The Association will not be responsible for any injuries incurred on the day.
- If the weather is extremely cold 11&under players can wear a long sleeve top under their dress that corresponds to dress colour.
- Provisional draws will be available on our website on the Friday before our Tournament. Late changes may occur.
